

**SOUTH JERSEY BARONS / BANSHEES YOUTH CLUB
PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT**

It is expected that the players for the South Jersey Barons and Banshees Youth Club will conduct themselves like young professionals both on and off the playing field. The Board of Directors and Coaching staff will not tolerate any unsportsmanlike or derogatory conduct or behavior during training, practice sessions, games, tournaments, or any other Club function or event (hereinafter referred to as "Activity").

As a player for the South Jersey Barons and Banshees, I hereby promise to uphold the following Code of Conduct:

1. I promise to maintain a positive attitude during all Activities.
2. I promise to be punctual and ready for all times that I am required to be present for all Activities. Permission to be absent from training for reasons other than illness or appointment, family emergency, legal obligation, religious observance, or pre-arranged field trip must be obtained from the coach prior to the absence.
3. I promise to be a team player and be an encouragement to my fellow teammates at all times.
4. I promise to follow the directions of my coaches and trainers.
5. I promise to respect my teammates, coaches and trainers. I will accept the authority of my coach when disciplined.
6. I promise to respect and not criticize opposing players, coaches or teams.
7. I promise to respect and not criticize officials.
8. I promise that I will not use foul or degrading language while a player for the club.
9. I promise that I will not engage in any fighting or flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct during any Activity.

Club players shall be subject to the following penalties for not adhering to the above code of conduct:

1. Two unexcused absences from training and or practice sessions will result in disciplinary action at the discretion of the coach.
2. Disrespect to the coach during training and/or practice sessions = sit the remainder of the session.
3. Striking a teammate during training and/or practice sessions = suspension 2 training and/or practice sessions and 1 game (first offense).

4. Disruptive behavior during training and/or practice sessions = sit the remainder of the session.
5. Dissent (disrespect) towards the referee or assistant referees = substituted immediately.
6. Dissent (disrespect) towards the referee or assistant referees / getting a yellow card = sit out the remainder of the game. (Discretion of coach/trainer)
7. Dissent (disrespect) towards the referee or assistant referees / getting a red card = automatic suspension by the League for 1 game, plus 1 game.
8. Retaliation / getting a yellow card = substituted immediately.
9. Retaliation / getting a red card = automatic suspension by the league for one game, plus 1 game (depending on how severe the situation is).
10. Disrespect to home or Opposing coaching staff = immediate substitution / playing time reduced.
11. Spitting at the opposition = sit out the remainder of the game, plus 1 additional game suspension.
12. Unsportsmanlike conduct on or off the field = Up to one game suspension, depending on the severity of the infraction for the first offense.
13. Parent carded or Coach / Liaison carded as a result of Parent behavior, Player suspended for one game, Parent fined \$25 and parent responsible for fines levied on Club.
14. **off the field activities:** The Board of Directors in consultation with the liaison, Coach and the Technical Director will decide on the action to be taken depending on the seriousness of the incident.

The player acknowledges that he has read this Players Code of Conduct and has discussed it with his parent(s) and/or guardian, and that he understands it meaning and effect.

SOUTH JERSEY BARONS / BANSHEES YOUTH CLUB PARENT'S CODE OF CONDUCT

It is expected that parents of players of the South Jersey Barons and Banshees Youth Club (AClub) shall conduct themselves in a manner that is of the highest standards while at training, practice sessions, games, tournaments, or any other function or event or tournaments. The Board of Directors and Coaching staff **will not tolerate any** unsportsmanlike or derogatory behavior during training, practice sessions, games, tournaments, or any other function or event when the players are representing the Club.

As a parent of a player for the South Jersey Barons and Banshees, I hereby pledge to provide support, care and encouragement for my child and promise to uphold the following Code of Conduct:

- 1.** I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and opposing player, coaches and teams.
- 2.** I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of any personal desire to win.
- 3.** I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- 4.** I will provide support for coaches, liaison and officials training and working with my child to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all.
- 5.** I will demand a drug, alcohol and tobacco free sports environment for my child and all children, and agree to assist by refraining from their use at any and all Club activities.
- 6.** I will remember that the game is for the children and not for the adults.
- 7.** I will do my best to make this sports activity fun for my child and all participating children.
- 8.** I will ask my child to treat all players, coaches, fans, liaison and officials with respect regardless of sex, creed or ability.

9. I will help my child enjoy their sports experience within my personal constraints by assisting with finances, being a respectful fan, providing transportation or whatever I am capable of doing to support my child and the Club.

10. I agree not to stand near the training and/or practice area and will maintain a distance of approximately 100 yards away from training and/or practice activities so as not to cause a distraction during same.

11. I will not approach the trainers or coaches before; during or after a training and/or practice session and games unless prior, mutually agreed upon arrangements have been made.

12. I will not coach any player or interfere with any coaching activities during the training and/or practice sessions or games.

13. I agree not to criticize or make any disparaging comments about any player, coach, or official during training and/or practice sessions or games.

14. I agree and promise that I will not direct, instruct, lecture or coach my child during matches and will only cheer with words of encouragement.

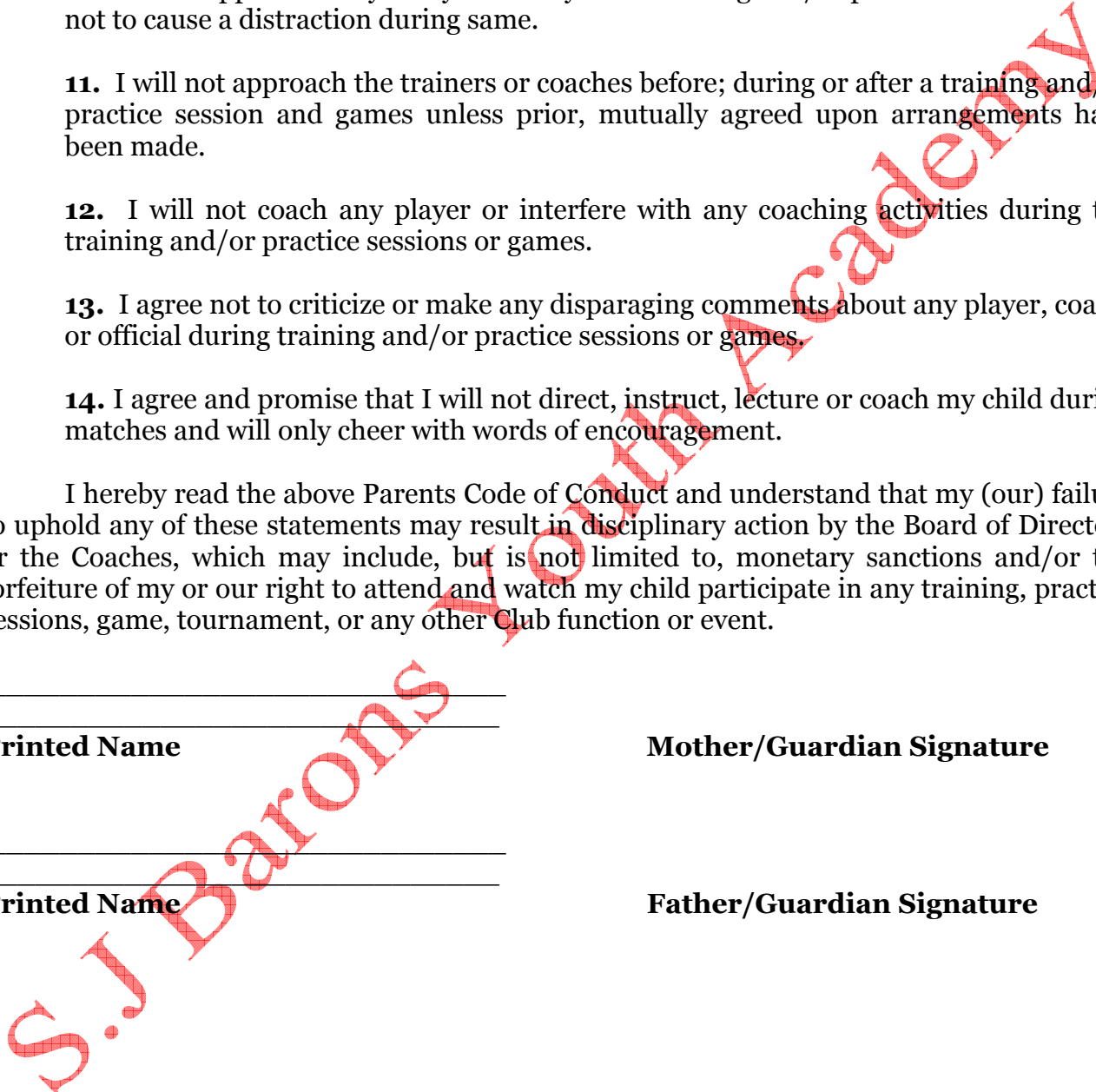

SOUTH JERSEY BARONS / BANSHEES YOUTH CLUB LIABILITY RELEASE AND WAIVER

The parties to this Release are _____ (Player),
_____ (Player's Mother/Guardian) and
_____ (Player's Father/Guardian) (if the Player is under the age of
eighteen (18) all referred to hereinafter jointly and severally as "Player") and the Board of
Directors of the South Jersey Barons/Banshees Youth Club (hereinafter referred as the "Youth
Club").

The Player with the consent of the Player's parents or legal guardians (where
applicable), has chosen to participate in soccer (hereinafter referred to as "Activity").

Assumption of Risk

Player expressly understands and agrees that participating in soccer presents risks to
the Player both serious and minor, including but not limited to head or other injuries, loss of
sight, broken bones, brain damage, paralysis and death. Player is responsible for researching
and evaluating the risks he may face and is solely responsible for his actions.

Player further recognizes, understands and agrees that the Youth Club assumes no
responsibility for any liability, damage or injury that may be caused by the Player's negligence
or willful acts committed prior to, during or after participation in the Activity, of for any liability,
damage or injury caused by the intentional or negligent acts or omissions of any other
participant in the Activity, or caused by any other person.

Indemnification and Hold Harmless

Player specifically understands that he is personally responsible, agrees to indemnify
and hold harmless the Board of Directors of the South Jersey Barons/Banshees Youth Club,
their officers, agents, volunteers, and employees from any action, claim or demand that his
heirs, or legal representatives, have or may have for any and all personal injuries he may
suffer or sustain, regardless of cause or fault as a result of his voluntary decision to participate
in the Activity or related activities, wherever such Activity may take place, including reasonable
attorney's fees and/or any other associated costs, caused by any act or omission of Student
resulting from direct or indirect participation in the Activity.

Release of Claims

In consideration of being allowed to participate in the Activity, Player, his heirs,
executors, administrators, employers, agents, representatives, insurers and attorneys, hereby
release and discharge the Board of Directors of the South Jersey Barons/Banshees Youth
Club, their officers, agents, volunteers, and employees (hereinafter referred to as "Released
Parties") from any and all claims which may arise from any cause whatsoever, including any
negligent act or omission by the Released Parties. Player further releases and discharges the
Released Parties from liability for any accident, illness, injury, loss or damage to personal
property, or any other consequences arising or resulting directly or indirectly from Player's

participation in the Activity. The Player acknowledges and agrees that the Released Parties assume no responsibility for any liability, damage, or injury that may be caused by Player's negligent or intentional acts or omissions committed prior to, during or after participation in the Activity, or for any liability, damage or injury caused by the intentional or negligent acts or omissions of any other participant in the Activity, or caused by any other person.

Termination of Participation

Player understands and agrees to abide by all policies, rules, regulations and specifically, the South Jersey Barons/Banshees Youth Club Players Code of Conduct (hereinafter referred to as the "Code of Conduct"). Player understands that, in its sole discretion the Youth Club or its representative may terminate the Player's participation in the Activity at any time. Reasons for termination are set forth in Code of Conduct, but may also include, but not limited to: in appropriate conduct or other behavior by the Player deemed detrimental to the best interest of the Activity or other participants; emergencies; failure to pay; or health or safety considerations.

Physical Condition and Insurance

Player attests that he is physically capable of participating in the Activity and has no known health restrictions that might jeopardize his safety or health or the safety or health of others during their participation in the Activity.

Player further attests that he possesses private healthcare insurance that will be responsible for all costs and expenses of any medical treatment for any damage or injury to the Player that may be caused by engaging in the Activity.

Severability

It is understood and agreed by the parties hereto that, if any clause or provision of this release and waiver or the application thereof is held illegal, invalid, or unenforceable under present or future laws the illegal, invalid or unenforceable clause or provision shall not affect other clause, provision or applications of this release and waiver which can be given effect without the invalid clause, provision or application. To this end, the clauses and provisions of this release and waiver are declared severable.

Governing Law and Venue

This release and waiver shall be construed in accordance with, and governed by, the Laws of the State of New Jersey. The venue for any action arising out of this release and waiver shall be the County of Camden, State of New Jersey. The parties agree to submit to jurisdiction in Camden County, New Jersey. The parties hereto hereby waive any defenses based upon the venue, the inconvenience of the forum, the lack of personal jurisdiction, the sufficiency of service of process or the like in any such action or suit brought in the State of New Jersey.

Construction and Scope of Release and Waiver

The language of all parts of this release and waiver shall in all cases be construed as a whole, according to its fair meaning, and not strictly for or against any party. This release and waiver supersedes any earlier written or oral understandings of agreements between the parties regarding the within matters.

Player, his mother/guardian, and his father/guardian, acknowledges that they have read this release and waiver and that they understand its meaning and effect.
